BLAUBURGUNDER 2013

- **Description:** the Blauburgunder (Pinot Nero) is, as the name suggests, from the French wine region of Burgundy. Our best south-facing location combined with the lime-rich, sandy clay soil give this bright ruby-red wine its taste: an elegant play of light spices and roasted aromas, red berries, sour cherries and delicate tannins.
- **Vinification:** in stainless steel tanks, then fermentation and maturation in small oak casks.
- **Vine training:** approx. 20-year old pergola system
- **Location:** south-facing location at approx. 450 metres a.s.l. on 45% slope
- **Climate:** Alpine-Mediterranean
- **Analytical values:** alcohol content 13.5% vol., total acidity 4.7 g/hl, residual sugar 2.8 g/hl
- **Yield:** 45 hl/ha
- **Storage:** up to 5 years
- **Recommended with:** ideal with white meat dishes
- **Serving temperature:** 16–18°C
