



BLAUBURGUNDER 2013

- **Description:** the Blauburgunder (Pinot Nero) is, as the name suggests, from the French wine region of Burgundy. Our best south-facing location combined with the lime-rich, sandy clay soil give this bright ruby-red wine its taste: an elegant play of light spices and roasted aromas, red berries, sour cherries and delicate tannins.
- Vinification: in stainless steel tanks, then fermentation and maturation in small oak casks.
- Vine training: approx. 20-year old pergola system
- Location: south-facing location at approx. 450 metres a.s.l. on 45% slope
- o Climate: Alpine-Mediterranean
- Analytical values: alcohol content 13.5% vol., total acidity 4.7 g/hl, residual sugar 2.8 g/hl
- Yield: 45 hl/ha
- **o Storage:** up to 5 years
- Recommended with: ideal with white meat dishes
- Serving temperature: 16–18°C
