



ZWEIGELT 2013

- **Description:** the Blue Zweigelt variety originates from Austria and is rare in South Tyrol. Consistent regulation of yields creates a powerful red wine with velvety tannins and fine spices. Typical of Blue Zweigelt is its intense ruby-red with violet reflexes. The aroma is slightly roasted, reminiscent of dark berries, elderberries and plums.
- Vinification: in stainless steel tanks, then fermentation and maturation in small oak casks.
- Vine training: guyot
- Location: southeast-facing, sheltered, at approx. 500 metres a.s.l. on 55% slope
- o Climate: Alpine-Mediterranean
- Analytical values: alcohol content 13.5 % vol., total acidity 5.1 g/hl, residual sugar 1.5 g/hl
- Yield: 50 hl/ha
- **o Storage:** up to 5 years
- Recommended with: ideale robust meat and game dishes
- Serving temperature: 18–20°C
